- Sponsorship. Check if the enterprise or individual meet that requirement.


Checking visa requirements are key, as most of the UKVI website does not contain the full information. The reason is simple, its not possible to place everyone's circumstances in one place.

**Is it important to write a cover letter?** Yes, this helps Officials to look at the evidences presented and how the requirements have been met.

**Does my sponsor need to write their own statement?** Absolutely, this is a key document and ownership of their sponsorship.

Evidences play a critical pathway to a successful visa application. Ensure you put together the right information and evidences.
